

## US Gas Processing and LNG Map

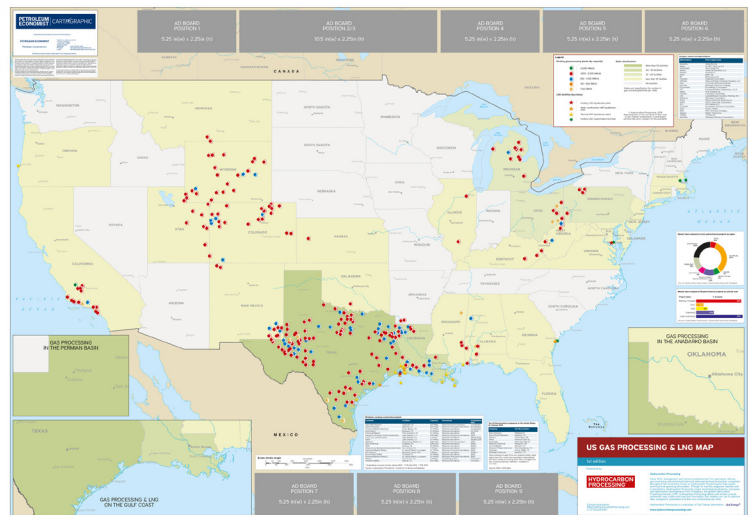
Due to the shale gas production boom, the gas processing and LNG industries in the US have witnessed a substantial increase in capital investments over the past several years. These capital investments include the construction of additional processing capacity, along with thousands of miles of new pipeline infrastructure. Midstream operators have invested billions of dollars in the construction of additional US gas processing facilities, adding several billion cubic feet of additional processing capacity. The US has also announced more than 36 LNG export terminal projects. These projects equate to more than 330 MMtpy of new liquefaction capacity by 2030 at a cost of nearly \$200 B. This buildout will move the US from being the 16th largest LNG exporter (2016) to the second- or third-largest LNG exporter by the end of the decade, depending on additional capacity that may go online in Australia.
